This 14-hour course, followed by an exam, provides broad training in proper installation and service requirements for commercial and household fire alarm systems based on NFPA and ICC codes. NFPA requires fire inspection and testing personnel to be knowledgeable and trained, and service personnel to be qualified and experienced. Students will learn the information needed for professionals to become familiar with fire alarm system requirements necessary to gain certification and prove competence. It will provide individuals with the knowledge and skills to install and maintain fire alarm systems that comply with NFPA 72 and NFPA 70.
